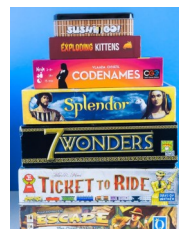

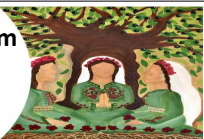

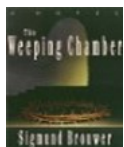
The Season of Lent

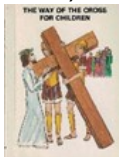
