Dear Friends in Christ,

As we celebrate Triduum in our Church, we are reminded of Christ's Passion, death and resurrection. Jesus took the sins of all of us upon himself, that through his death all might live, fully alive, free from slavery of sin and called to eternal life. *For God did not sent his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him.*


In the Word of God, proclaimed in our midst, we hear the themes of passing from darkness to light, from blindness to sight, from alienation to restoration.
