

The CWL would like to give a huge thank you to the Parishioners of Sacred Heart for their ongoing support with the refugee efforts in Red Deer. Sacred Heart has been supporting this initiative since 2011. The need is great and we would not be able to accommodate it without your support.

2023 was our busiest year and 2024 is predicted to have 100 more refugees. We support families and single people with a bag of basic essentials. These bags are delivered to Catholic Social Services and provided upon arrival. These bags consist of Shampoo, dish soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, a bar of soap, combs, a dish cloth, tea towel and a welcoming note from CWL.

We currently need clean reusable bags (big and small), bars of soap, dish soap (large and small), hair combs, dish cloths, adult toothbrushes, tea towels, and shampoo (large and small).
