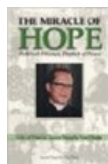
**Refugee Bags:** Big thank you to our parishioners for your

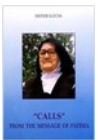

scheduling your child's Baptism.**

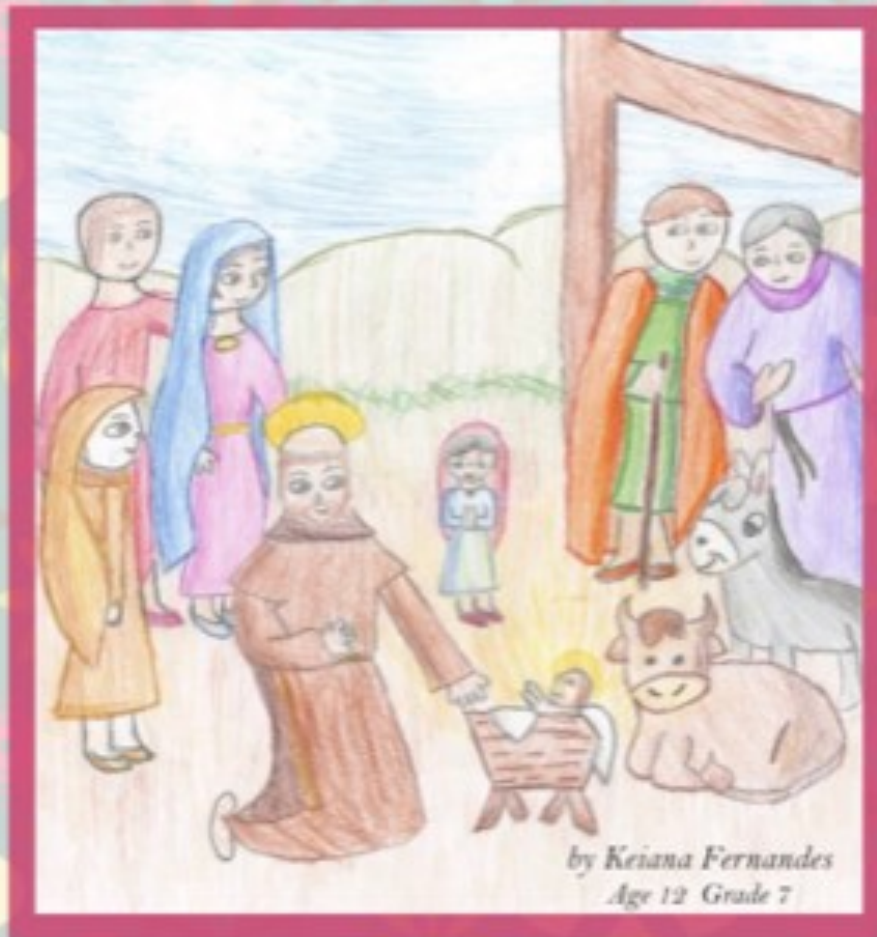
