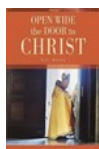
All proceeds are going to purchase a new stove in our parish kitchen.

Baptism Preparation is held once a month, and is required for parents to attend before scheduling your child's Baptism.

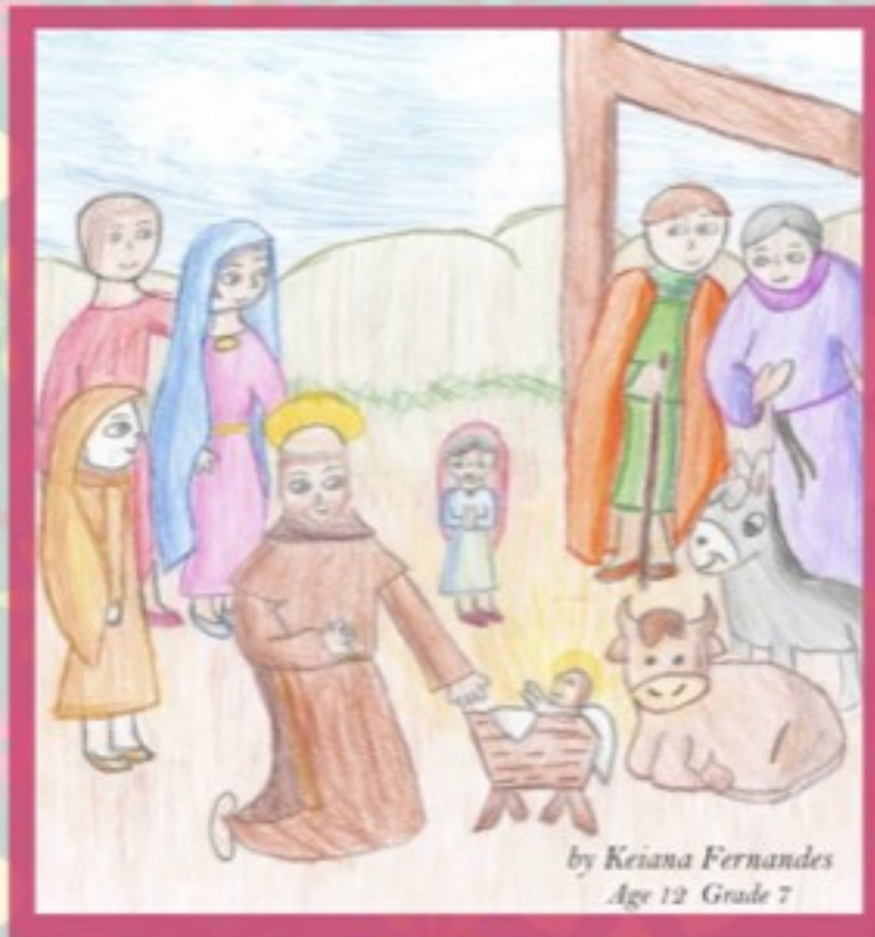
