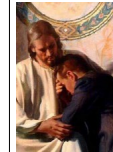

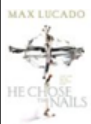

The Season of Lent

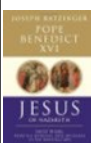

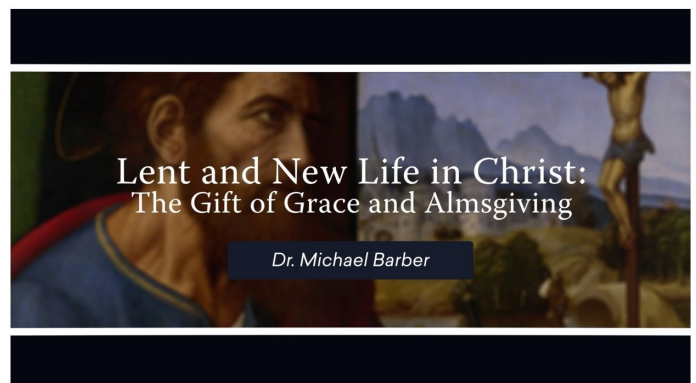
