Will Assisted Suicide save Health-care Dollars? A new study in Canadian Medical Association Journal suggests that doctor-assisted suicide could save Canada up to \$139 million each year. The authors go to pains to state they aren't suggesting people be voluntarily euthanized to save money. But it's well known that the last months of life are often costly to the health-care system -- is it only a matter of time before costs determine how we treat our most vulnerable patients?
