Sacred Heart Parish, under the direction of the Archdiocese of Edmonton, is in charge of caring for our beautiful cemetery.

Mount Calvary Catholic Cemetery is a perpetual care facility.

Directions:

Travel West on 67th street. Go past the lights at the Save-On-Foods by about 100 feet. Entrance is on the North side of 67th street.

VISITING HOURS

Daily during **daylight hours**. Anyone found in the cemetery after dark is subject to prosecution.

Mount Calvary is **not liable** for any damages or losses to memorials or decorations resulting from theft, vandalism, mishaps or natural causes.

The Caretaker may remove any item that in any way becomes:

- + detrimental to the aesthetics or functionality of the cemetery,
- + impedes maintenance, or
- + imposes a health and wellness risk.

WHAT CAN I LEAVE?

We encourage **fresh flowers**.

Artificial flowers are also welcome.

Seasonal decorations such as **wreaths and crosses** are permitted from November to March.

If unsure, check with cemetery staff or the Sacred Heart Parish Office.

WHAT IS NOT PERMITTED?

No glass or breakable objects.

No planting of any kind may be done on graves.

No solar lights.

No unattended candles. No open flames.

No structures, fences or railings.

WHERE DID IT GO?

The cemetery assumes no liability for any left item. Do not leave valuables.

Wilted flowers will be removed.

Unightly, inappropriate, or dirty decorations will be removed.

Anything that poses a health risk will be removed.

Unauthorized items will be removed **without notice** by the Caretaker.

HEADSTONES

All memorials must be approved by Caretaker before installation. Different parts of the cemetery have distinct headstone requirements.

Maximum headstone height is **26"** depending upon cemetery section.

Family is responsible to maintain headstone and grave plot in an acceptable condition.

CONTACT INFORMATION

Plot holders or family may need to be contacted by cemetery staff. Please help keep our records up to date by providing us a **current** mailing address, phone number, and/or email.

BURIAL OPTIONS

- † Internment of body in full-size plot with grave liner with 'raised' headstone
- † Burial of cremated remains in a cremation plot with 'flush with ground' headstone
- † Placement of urn containing cremated remains in a columbarium niche with an engraved niche door

A second burial may be permitted in an existing grave. The second headstone must be flush with the ground and smaller than the first.
