ZEALOUS DEFENDER OF CHRIST

- ◆ Mark it on your calendar & plan to arrive at least 10 min. prior to the start of Mass.

- ◆ If you do not have access to the internet please call the Parish office **by 8:00am on Friday** to register for Mass.
