Whether it is a sacrament or a prayer, we always begin in the name of the Father, of the Son and of the Holy Spirit-the Trinity. Today, we take a moment to reflect on this sacred Mystery. One God, three persons. Something not so easy to comprehend. Normally we identify one of the three when used in conversation. One thing we must understand is that God is a loving community of people. Father loves son, Son loves Father, the fruit of this mutual love is the gift of the Holy Spirit. This space itself is our Christianity where God is not a stranger to us. God is not only revealed to us, He not only gives us a model to follow, but He wants us to understand that we have a share in the same love that exists in the Holy Trinity. This is also a personal invitation to live in community with Him and each other. Through this community we discover that through this love we can let go of our selfishness. Life has meaning when we live for others. There is not better access to Him than by the love we offer to another person. God not only wants to be someone who wraps us in His love, He wants to be present in our lives, just as in the Trinity. To be one in the Trinity.

## **FR. TOM'S FAREWELL:**


