Today we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles and us. "Suddenly from the sky came a loud sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the whole house." Such an important event that changed the face of the earth. Now filled with the Holy Spirit, the apostles began to preach the Gospel to the whole earth. They were not afraid to be a witness to Jesus Christ after his death on the cross. The Holy Spirit is therefore, the only explanation for ordinary people in a very short time, to carry the local word of God to the world, attracting new followers to Christ. The same Holy Spirit fills our church today giving us the same energy to be witnesses to the resurrection. However, when we look at a Christian life it seems that the Holy Spirit is kept in a closed tabernacle, we do not allow him to act in our hearts. We have to be the temple that takes Jesus out into the streets and evangelizes the Gospel. If we are closed to the presence of the Holy Spirit, we will be like the apostles after the crucifixion, scared to witness. Today we get another chance to be open to the Holy Spirit and to learn to exceed our imperfections and our possibilities. If at this time you're not open to the Holy Spirit and his gifts, or do not use them responsibly but squander them, you will also be responsible for those who do not hear the gospel and were not told about the love of God.


## **SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE**
